The Australian Commission on Safety and Quality in Health Care (the Commission) is conducting consultations to develop the requirements of the <u>National One Stop Shop</u> for health-related human research approvals and the <u>National Clinical Trials Front Door</u>.

The goal of the National One Stop Shop and National Clinical Trials Front Door is to make it easier for patients, researchers, industry representatives and sponsors to find, conduct, participate and invest in high quality and ethical research in Australia.

The Commission is hosting three public consultations to provide an update to the research community on the work undertaken to date and gather feedback on the user requirements for the national platform.
