This intensive 7-week course aims to help you develop the customer discovery skills needed to advance your product or business. During the course, you will work interactively in small groups to learn how to conduct stakeholder interviews to gather data and insights to build out a business model. You will receive feedback from experts in this sector. The course runs in-person and online every Thursday between **11 August – 22 September 2022**.

**Applications close on 21st July 2022. Limited spots available.**

**What will I learn?** At the end of this course you will have developed knowledge and immersed yourself on a wide range of skills, including:

- Identifying your customer, payer, and user.
- Talking about your idea without divulging protected information
- Communicating technical and scientific information in an accessible way

- Incorporating your insights into your business plan and product development
- Pitching, performance, and presentation skills.
