The Research Governance Office (RGO), Tasmanian Department of Health, is seeking a suitably experienced Research Governance Officer for a short fixed-term casual contract to start immediately. This opportunity can be offered as working remotely.

The RGO is implementing an IT system to manage research governance projects and is seeking to progress existing paper-based submissions expeditiously to make the transition to the IT system as seamless as possible.

The applicant does need experience in reviewing governance submissions from researchers for multi-centre collaborative and/or investigator-initiated research and clinical trials, providing advice to researchers on their submissions before progressing to the Delegated Authority for institutional authorisation.

The successful applicant will be employed through the Tasmanian Department of Health. A Statement of Duties, inclusive of Classification Level and Salary is attached. The applicant would need to have their own computer and internet access. Provision for the reasonable reimbursement toward internet costs and for administrative costs incurred from working remotely is included.
