CPI/PI Delegation Functionality Now Live

The CPI/PI delegation functionality was released on Wednesday 19th October.

The main functionality of this enhancement allows Coordinating Principal Investigator's and Principal Investigator's to delegate the administrative task of submitting applications and forms in REGIS. This **does not** remove the overall responsibility of the study from the CPI or the overall responsibility of the study at the site from the PI.

From Wednesday 19th October, any user delegated 'Submit' access can now complete administrative tasks such as submitting applications, requests for further information, amendments, safety reports and milestones!
