

REGIS Updates: Live from Wednesday 14 February 2024

We are pleased to announce the forthcoming updates to REGIS, which will be live in the system from Wednesday 14 February 2024. These updates demonstrate a commitment to staying current with regulatory standards, improving system functionality to meet user needs, and enhancing the overall research experience within REGIS.

HREA Form Update

Purpose: The HREA (Human Research Ethics Application) form has been updated to align with the revised National Statement on Ethical Conduct in Human Research 2023.

Changes: Users will notice minor updates to the form, including changes to guidance text and references to the revised National Statement. These changes ensure compliance with current ethical guidelines and standards.

Introduction of ACT Health STE to REGIS

Purpose: ACT Health will now be using the STE (SSA) functionality in REGIS.

Changes: Canberra Hospital will now be able to generate and create an STE application within REGIS. This integration enables ACT Health to manage both Ethics and Sites within REGIS, streamlining administrative processes and enhancing efficiency in research management.

Project Registration Form Updates

Purpose: The Project Registration form has been enhanced to capture and report consumer involvement for research projects.

Data Capture: Under the existing project registration, consumer involvements for research projects are captured and while these data points exist, they are not reportable.

The NSW eHealth REGIS team has been working tirelessly to enable the reportability of these questions and are happy to confirm that all the selections captured previously and for any new project registrations will now be accessible via the Consumer Involvement (PR) Dashboard.
