

Tasmanian Health Ethics Low or Negligible Risk (LNR) Studies in REGIS

We are excited to announce the introduction of Tasmanian Health Ethics Low or Negligible Risk (LNR) studies into REGIS. With this introduction, Tasmanian LNR Ethics will now be managed entirely within REGIS.

What does this mean in REGIS? Users will now be able to select the Tasmanian Low Risk Human Research Ethics Committee during Project Registration (*Part B: Project Details*). Once selected, a message appears that advises users that the only sites that can be created in REGIS under this Tasmanian Ethics application are Tasmanian related Centres and Sites (*Part C: Research Site/s*). The system will not allow for other sites to be selected for creation of Site applications (STEs) in REGIS.
