Reminder: How to Activate Inactive HODs in REGIS

When a Department can be selected in the SSA but the Name of the HOD doesn't appear.

Audience: Research Office

Issue: Researchers are finding instances where a Department can be selected in the SSA but the HOD name doesn't appear. As a result Researchers are calling the Helpdesk, Research Offices or submitting the application without the name......all common sense approaches.

Reason: The vendor has informed that a base system upgrade has caused user details that were previously visible to be filtered out of the dropdown lists as the Position is indicated as "inactive".

While there are legitimate reasons for these positions to be inactive, there are examples where inactive positions have no expiry date (expiry dates exist when positions have been made inactive).

Action: If a Researcher contacts your team with this issue or you receive an SSA that is missing a HOD you can rectify this issue quickly without the assistance of the REGIS Technical Helpdesk or REGIS TEAM (cutting out the middle men will make this much faster for your Researchers), using the link below.

How to re-activate an inactive HOD

If you would like to tackle this issue head on the eHealth REGIS team can send out a spreadsheet listing all of the inactive HODs in REGIS. You can then use the guidance document (linked above) to determine if the position was made inactive by the eHealth REGIS team or F1, if there is no history showing that this was modified by a member of the eHealth REGIS team or Vendor then it can be re-activated.
